During a typical tribe meeting all Adventure Guides participants (both father and child) should wear a leather vest which they attach their patches. A picture of a vest and locations for various yearly patches are found on page 32. The Adventure Guides Program patch and yearly patches are included with enrollment each year. All participants wear a "Name Tag" at every meeting. Making a name tag is a good craft to do at your first meeting. Tribes are also encouraged to individualize your tribe by making custom patches for your tribal events, making a flag with your tribe's logo, or having custom tribe T-Shirts made. 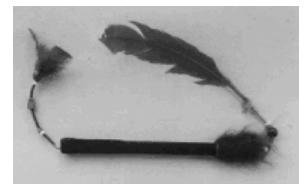
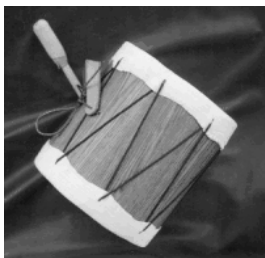
