NOW WHAT IS FLAGPOLE, REVEILLE, APPLE HOUR, ETC?!?!

ADVENTURE GUIDES GLOSSARY:

CHECK-IN: *(NOUN)* THE TIME IN WHICH ONE “CHECKS-IN”; *(VERB)* THE ACT OF CHECKING IN AT AN OUTING.

EVENING PROGRAM: *(NOUN)* THE PROGRAM WHICH IS DONE DURING THE EVENING;
EXAMPLES: POOL PARTY, MIDNIGHT ROCK AND ROLL GLOW IN THE DARK TOWER CLIMBING, ETC.

TAPS: *(NOUN)* A BUGLE PLAYED AT THE END OF THE DAY TO SIGNAL LIGHTS OUT.

LIGHTS OUT: *(NOUN)* THE TIME IN WHICH LIGHTS ARE TURNED OUT AND QUIET TIME IS OBSERVED; *(VERB)* THE ACT OF TURNING OUT LIGHTS.

REVEILLE: *(VERB)* THE SOUNDING OF A BUGLE EARLY IN THE MORNING TO AWAKEN DADS AND KIDS; *(NOUN)* THE BUGLE THAT SALTY DOG BLOWS EARLY IN THE MORNING TO WAKE UP THE ENTIRE CAMP.

FLAGPOLE: 1. *(NOUN)* THE GATHERING AT THE FLAGPOLE BEFORE MEALS; SOMETIMES INCLUDES RAISING OR LOWERING THE NATIONAL FLAG.
2. *(NOUN)* THE POLE THAT THE FLAG IS ATTACHED TO.

SKITS: *(NOUN)* THE TIME AFTER DINNER IN WHICH THE KIDS OF EACH TRIBE CAN PRESENT A SKIT TO THE REST OF THE OTHER TRIBES. EACH SKIT LASTS 2-4 MINUTES AND INCLUDES ALL KIDS IN THE TRIBE.

CAMPFIRE: *(NOUN)* CEREMONIAL FIRE ON SATURDAY EVENING IN WHICH TORCHES ARE CARRIED, VESTS WORN, AND TRIBES COME TOGETHER.

APPLE HOUR: *(NOUN)* THE SUNDAY SERVICE FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS; A TIME OF INDIVIDUAL TIME WITH EACH OF YOUR CHILDREN; A PERIOD TO REFLECT WITH YOUR CHILDREN THE TIME THAT EACH OF YOU HAVE SPENT TOGETHER; SPENDING TIME WITH YOUR CHILD AWAY FROM EVERYONE ELSE WHILE SHARING AN APPLE; AN HOUR ON SUNDAY MORNING IN WHICH YOU SHARE AN APPLE WITH YOUR KIDS WHILE REFLECTING ON YOUR TIME TOGETHER; THE MOST BELOVED PART OF ANY OUTING.

DISMISS: *(VERB)* LEAVE CAMP AND GO HOME!!!
